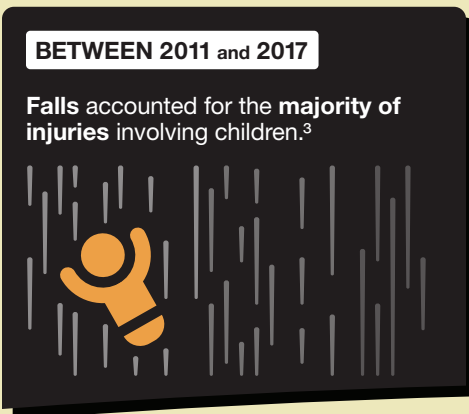
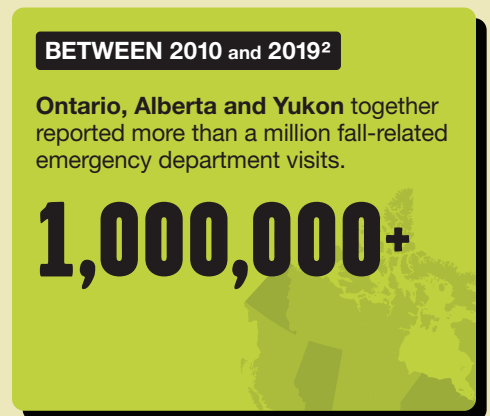
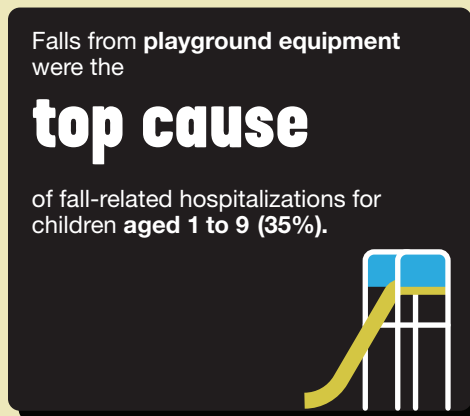
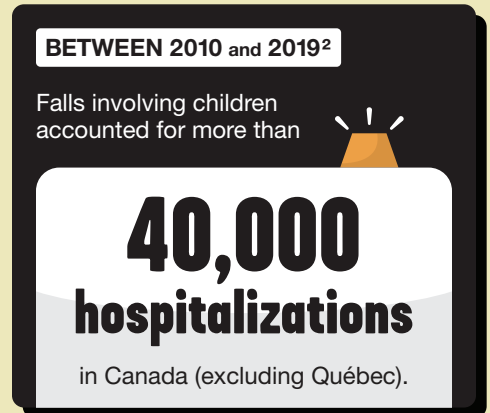
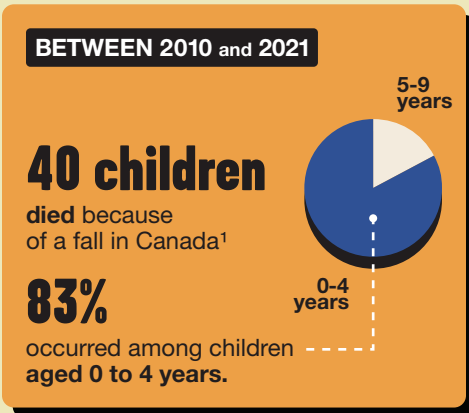


Falls are the **No. 1 reason** children are admitted to hospital for an injury
